CONSENT AGENDA:

- Approval of Treasurer's Report and minutes from August 27, 2023. Rinker/Pittman.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- At 6:00PM an hour-long special meeting took place with the Finance Committee and Vestry to discuss the audit report. At the conclusion of the report, the official Vestry meeting began at 7:00PM.
- Junior Warden Julia Greene reported on the construction project and provided samples of the furniture selection for the Youth Room. \$71, 833.63 is the cost, and a check for half that amount will be sent as a deposit. The roofers should begin the new roof in 1-2 weeks, and the goal is matching the roof, brick and cap to the rest of the church. Concrete has been poured for the ramp from the rear parking lot. A plumber has taken measurements for the bathroom. It is hoped the entire project will be finished by Advent.

- Jeremy Landers is waiting to hear the start date for installation of the fire alarm.
- Dr. Stuart Deaderick has been announced as the next Senior Warden.
- Stuart announced that there will be 2 questions on the back of next Sunday's bulletin and online. The results will be collected after the service and entered into a word cloud.
